Hello Collectors

Welcome to the July–August edition of *Stamp Bulletin*. We do hope you are faring well and staying connected during these strange new times. As previously advised, our Post Offices continue to provide support and services to the community, and postal delivery is a reminder that essential services remain in place with little change. Similarly, the philatelic team continues to develop new stamp issues – albeit through very different processes – and 1 am pleased to introduce our forthcoming issues in this edition of *Stamp Bulletin*.

Our July–August stamp issues mark two important anniversaries. First is the sesquicentenary of the establishment of Melbourne's Royal Children's Hospital in 1870. This important medical institution was founded as a free hospital for sick children, and it continues to offer paediatric care free of charge. Second is the centenary of the Princes Highway, which opened in 1920. This major arterial road connects Sydney to Melbourne via New South Wales' South Coast and Victoria's Gippsland.

Two July–August stamp issues relate to natural processes that have occurred over millions of years. Geological forces created the Australian Alps, which stretch from Canberra through southern New South Wales and into Victoria, along the Great Dividing Range. The alps are a favoured destination for outdoor enthusiasts year-round. Age-old natural processes are also responsible for fossil formation. Australia was once part of the ancient supercontinent Gondwana, where, over millions of years, plant and animal remains were buried in its waterways. Some of these remains were transformed into remarkable opalised fossils.


Stamp Collecting Month focuses on a subject of great urgency following Australia's recent devastating bushfire season. Bushfires claimed the lives of an unprecedented number of native animals, pushing some species towards extinction. Wildlife Recovery draws attention to the plight of our native wildlife and the need for comprehensive conservation measures.

Two territories stamp issues also focus on animal species: Christmas Island Crabs represents four crab species, while Norfolk Island Ocean Oddities features two rarely encountered fish species that can be found in the open ocean around Norfolk Island.



In 1870, a ladies committee, along with doctors John Singleton and William Smith, established the Melbourne Free Hospital for Sick Children. Opening its doors on 9 September 1870 with only six rooms, the hospital aimed to give the best care to sick and injured children, free of charge. In a century and a half, paediatric healthcare at The Royal Children's Hospital (RCH) Melbourne has advanced to the point that it is recognised as one of the world's great hospitals for children. Today, the vision of the RCH continues, as children and families from communities across Australia and around the world benefit from its legacy with great health outcomes, and still at no charge.


In 2011 a new 340-bed hospital, designed by Billard Leece Partnership and Bates Smart Architects, was opened by Queen Elizabeth II on a site in Parkville adjacent to the existing hospital. By November that year patients had been moved into the new facility and demolition of the old site was complete by December 2012. Much of the old site was turned into parkland, creating a new gateway to Royal Park.





Marine scientist and artist Dr Lindsay Marshall has illustrated this stamp issue. Her artwork gives significant detail of each species, and the graphic device of a diver conveys the relative size of the fish.

Although not commonly encountered, the two species occur in open oceans around Norfolk Island. The Bump-head Sunfish is usually found to depths of 5,000 metres, though occasionally ventures into shallow waters. This disc-like marine giant has a deep body that can be as large as 3.3 metres in diameter. The Oarfish, sometimes known as the King of Herrings, is a ribbon-like fish that can grow to 11 metres. The world's longest bony fish species, it occurs to a depth of around 1,000 metres. It is so named because of its long pelvic fins, which resemble oars.

The Australian Alps is a biodiverse and picturesque alpine region of around 1.6 million hectares that stretches from Canberra, in the Australian Capital Territory (ACT), through southern New South Wales (NSW), and along the Great Dividing Range in eastern Victoria.

The national-heritage-listed Australian Alps encompass 11 national parks and nature reserves that contain plant and animal life found nowhere else in Australia and, in some cases, the world. These rare alpine environments include fern-filled forests, Snow Gum woodlands and cirque lakes, as well as alpine meadows. There are incredible landforms created by glaciers and a range of rock types, with a geological history spanning hundreds of millions of years. In addition to the Alps' biodiversity, geological significance and impressive scenery, many of the region's waterways assist with electricity generation, irrigation and domestic water supply, including the mighty Snowy River.



This year's Stamp Collecting Month focuses on a subject of urgency following Australia's devastating bushfire season over the summer of 2019–20. The high-intensity fires swept through around 12 million hectares – including significant bushland and protected natural areas – claiming the lives of a conservatively estimated 1.25 billion animals. The immensity of this loss was compounded by the aftermath of the fires, which left many animals without food, water and shelter, and exposed to opportunistic predators.

The federal government's Wildlife and Threatened Species Bushfire Recovery expert panel has estimated that the many species identified for urgent conservation management had at least 30 per cent of their habitat destroyed by the fires; many species lost substantially more than this. They have been identified as particularly at-risk due to their level of imperilment before the bushfires, the extent to which their habitat has been burnt, and their specific traits that make them particularly vulnerable to fire.



Conservationists, scientists, government agencies, land managers, wildlife rescue and rehabilitation groups and individual carers mobilised rapidly in their rescue and recovery efforts. Their actions have included evacuating animals, establishing triage centres, making drops of supplementary food and water, establishing shelters and predator controls, monitoring, and fencing remnant vegetation. It is a long road to recovery, but the stories of success are cause for optimism for the survival of our much-loved wildlife. The stamps in this issue depict six animals from the federal government's expert panel's long list of priority species for urgent conservation management: Koala, Bathurst Copper Butterfly, Davies' Tree Frog, Kangaroo Island Dunnart, Regent Honeyeater and Blue Mountains Water Skink. All six species were considered at risk before the bushfires, but the level of their imperilment is greatly increased.







The Princes Highway was officially opened in 1920 as a major arterial road between Sydney and Melbourne via the New South Wales South Coast and Gippsland, in Victoria. The highway was named in honour of the Prince of Wales (later King Edward VIII and, after his abdication, the Duke of Windsor) on the occasion of his royal tour of Australia.


The first section from Melbourne was formally opened on 10 August 1920 at Warragul, Victoria,

and the New South Wales opening took place on 19 October in Bulli on the South Coast of New South Wales. In 1922, approval was given to extend the Princes Highway to Adelaide via Geelong, Warrnambool, Portland, Robe and Mount Gambier. It was later extended to Port Augusta.

This stamp issue commemorates the centenary of the Princes Highway, with early travel posters celebrating cities and towns along its length.

Opalised Fossils

Released 17 August 2020

During the early Cretaceous Period, around 125 to 100 million years ago, what is now Australia lay near the South Pole, joined to Antarctica as part of the ancient supercontinent Gondwana. Over millions of years, some of the plant and animal remains buried in its ancient waterways were transformed into opalised fossils. The opalised wood fossil featured on the stamp was found in the Koroit opal fields, in Queensland. While the identity of the tree species is unknown, it was likely a relative of today's Bunya Pine, a tree in

the Araucarian conifer group prevalent during the Cretaceous Period.

The pine cone (also most likely from an Araucarian conifer), theropod dinosaur tooth and wood fossils are part of the world's most diverse public collection of opalised fossils, housed at the Australian Opal Centre, at Lightning Ridge, in outback New South Wales. As well as its prized opalised fossils, the Australian Opal Centre has an important collection of precious opal, cultural artefacts, artworks, photographs and archival

materials relating to the history and heritage of opal in Australia. Recent discoveries in the area of Lightning Ridge include the plant-eating ornithopod dinosaurs Weewarrasaurus and Fostoria, and Australia's largest carnivorous dinosaur, nicknamed "Lightning Claw" for the impressive size of its claws (up to around 25 centimetres long).

The moon snail fossil found at Coober Pedy is from the South Australian Museum, which curates the world's largest collection of Australian precious opal in existence and devotes an entire display gallery to its renowned collection of opalised fossils. The species is *Euspira reflecta*, which was an active sea floor predator of mussels and cockles.

The opal fields of South Australia have yielded a treasure trove of opalised fossils over the century, since the first discovery of precious opal at Coober Pedy in 1915. South Australian opal occurrences are chiefly restricted to the sedimentary rocks of what is now the Great Artesian Basin.





In addition to 20 land crab species found on Christmas Island, more than 160 other species of crabs inhabit the island's reefs and shallows. The small, endemic Bright-eyed Crab (*Chiromantes garfunkel*) lives in cracks and crevices in the seacliff and rocks around the coast. Kuhl's Ghost Crab (*Ocypode kuhlii*) is a medium-sized crab found across South-East Asia and infrequently sighted on the island's Greta Beach.

The small vivid Red Nipper (*Geograpsus storm*i), found throughout the Indo-West Pacific region, conceals itself in cliff crevices and overhangs around the island's coastline. The extremely rare, tree-living White-striped Crab (*Labuanium vitatum*) is medium-sized and has been found on four Indian Ocean islands. It was only identified as a new species in 2011.
