On August 28th 2019 Post Authority of USA (USPS), issued set of four stamps dedicated to Tyrannosaurus rex. Last time Tyrannosaurus rex appeared on US stamps in 2010, but the stamp was dedicated to "Dinosaur Day" (stamp dedicated to dinosaurs as a whole) issued by USPS issued last time in 1997, "The World of Dinosaurs" - sheet of 15 stamps divided by two series: A series in Colorado, 150 million years ago on top and A series in Montana, 75 million years ago on the bottom.

Former stamps depicting the six-walking Tyrannosaurus rex in growth stages from infancy to adulthood and are always equal in value to the current First Class (44c) one-color price. But, because to philatelic annual stamps from 2015, these stamps also issued in 44c, two sets in a row with opposite stamps order. Every second row shows "super" combination 2 by 2 stamps.

Two stamps depict a newly hatched 7 cm covered with downy feathers and a teen-sized juvenile Tyrannosaurus rex chasing a granite mammal. The first illustration a horn-toe face cooperate with a Tyrannosaurus rex approaching through a forest clearing, another shows the same young which T rex with a young "Dinosaur" - both dinosaurs shown in fossil form.
